

Family Cycling



Please join us on some short fun rides suitable for riders 10 yrs. and older (no training wheels) or younger children on tag-alongs, tandems, in cargo box bikes, in trailers, or in bike-mounted child carriers. Routes will typically be 5-10 miles in length and may include stops along the way at parks, notable sites, trees, outdoor art, and maybe a bakery, ice cream, or candy store. The Summer Family Cycling Series also lists Sunday Parkways in Portland. [Sunday Parkways](#) are put on by the Portland Bureau of Transportation. These are loops of about 4.5 to 9.5 miles on neighborhood roadways that are closed to cars and open to pedestrians and bikes. You'll find food, music, dancing, and merriment! The Club does not host a family ride on these days, but they are great ways to spend a day with your family, either walking or cycling.
